GOLDEN BADGE COMPETITION

§10.

The applications for STN Golden Badge award are scored according to the following rules:

1. The applicant was the author (1st-4th author, excluding academic researchers) of work presented in a form of:

- Full oral presentation - 4 points
- Poster - 2 points
- Case report - 1 point

2. The following multipliers apply to the points for presenting the scientific work specified in point 1. §11:

2.1. If the work was presented during:

- *a student conference*: with a national scope (x1), with an international scope in Poland (x2), with an international scope outside Poland (x3)
- *a student congress*: with a national scope (x2.5), with an international scope in Poland (x4), with international scope outside Poland (x5)
- *symposium of doctors and specialists* (x5)
- *doctors' conference*: with a national scope (x7), with an international scope in Poland (x8), with an international scope outside Poland (x10)

2.2. If the presenter was the winner of the prize

- distinction / special prize (x1.5)
- 3rd place (x2)
- 2nd place (x3)
- 1st place (x4)

The following values constitute the third multiplier and should be calculated together with subsection 2.1

3. The applicant was the author of a publication in a scientific journal on the A list or the Ministry of Science and Higher Education list. Points are awarded according to the MNiSW score for 1st-4th authors, excluding

academic researchers. It should be noted that **only full-format publications** are considered. Abstracts printed in magazine supplements of symposiums/ medical congresses will not be recognized.

4. The following multipliers apply to points for publication of a scientific article set out in point 3. §11:

- a) author 3-4. (X1)
- b) author 2. (x2)
- c) author 1. (x3)
- d) corresponding author (x1.5) - **as the third multiplier**

5. He was the author of a chapter in a medical book or a monograph with a ISBN number - **10 points**

6. He was the recipient of a grant awarded by:

- National Science Center, National Center for Research and Development, Ministry of Science and Higher Education (excluding Diamond Grant and Best of the Best) or intermediate grants - **20 points**
- Diamond Grant - **15 points**
- The Best of the Best - **10 points**
- WUM mini-grant - **5 points**

7. He was a member of the organizing committee of:

- a Congress - **2 points**
- a Conference - **1 point**

8. The following multipliers apply to points for the organization of the congress / conference referred to in point 7. §11:

- with a national scope (x2)
- with an international scope (x4)

9. Positive opinion of the Student's Scientific Circle Supervisor and/or Head of the WUM unit, regarding activity in given SSC (**5 points**). A maximum of 5 points will be awarded for this activity.

10. Membership in the strict Management Board of student organizations (**5 points**). A maximum of 5 points will be awarded for this activity.
